PIPK is a Guangzhou-based womenswear development and manufacturing company working with fashion brands and retailers.

Since 2011, the company has focused on practical product development: understanding the intended garment, sourcing workable materials, building and reviewing samples, and carrying the approved standard into production.

The operating route is selected according to the buyer's starting point. PIPK can discuss OEM, ODM, FOB or CMT cooperation after the design, materials, quantity and buyer responsibility are clear.

ROUTE	TYPICAL STARTING POINT	PIPK DISCUSSION FOCUS
OEM	Buyer provides design direction, reference, tech pack or approved specification.	Product review, material sourcing if needed, sampling, manufacturing and quality follow-up.
ODM	Buyer needs development support around a market direction or product idea.	Design interpretation, fabric direction, pattern and sample development before production.
FOB	Buyer wants a finished-goods route with agreed commercial responsibility.	Materials, production, packing and shipment responsibility are confirmed style by style.
CMT	Buyer controls selected materials or specifications and needs cut-make-trim support.	Inputs, tolerances, workmanship, delivery and responsibility boundaries are documented.

PRACTICAL RULE

The cooperation label does not replace an order-specific scope. Confirm who owns design decisions, materials, tests, approvals, packing and logistics.



From reference to an approved production standard.



A sample is useful when the buyer and factory agree on what it must prove.

- ☐ Fit and proportion against the target customer.
- ☐ Fabric behaviour, opacity, recovery and drape.
- ☐ Construction, lining, support and seam method.
- ☐ Trims, specialist processes and finish.
- ☐ Measurements and acceptable tolerances.
- ☐ Changes closed before bulk cutting.



Material access is useful when the search is tied to the garment.



PIPK works close to Guangzhou's textile and trim supply network and cooperates with multiple fabric suppliers.

Core material directions include cotton, linen, wool and silk. Additional options and custom fabric developments can be discussed according to the product.

FIELD	BUYER AND FACTORY SHOULD CONFIRM
Identity	Composition, construction, article, finish and supplier.
Physical	Finished weight, usable width, hand feel and surface.
Performance	Shrinkage, recovery, colour, opacity and relevant testing.
Commercial	MOQ, stock, price basis, lead time and reorder route.
Approval	Physical swatch, colour standard and substitution boundary.

Review construction risk before promising price and timing.

STYLE FEATURE	DEVELOPMENT QUESTIONS	PRODUCTION CONTROL
Structured shoulders	Shape, padding, interlining, sleeve head and balance.	Approved internal construction and pressing reference.
Tailored collars	Roll line, stand, symmetry, edge and turn of cloth.	Pattern, fusing and pressing sequence.
Draped or bias panels	Grain, stretch, seam growth, hang and hem levelling.	Resting, cutting direction and handling rules.
Embroidery	Artwork, density, backing, placement and distortion.	Approved strike-off and placement tolerance.
Beading / handwork	Attachment, weight, comfort, repeatability and repair.	Placement map, workmanship standard and inspection.
Custom hardware	Finish, function, attachment and order minimum.	Approved sample, supplier reference and pull/function check.

PRICE NOTE

Complex embroidery, hand beading, custom trims, structured internal construction or low-volume material requirements may increase both sampling and production cost.

The figures on this page are not a binding quotation. PIPK confirms final price, timing and MOQ after reviewing the actual product.

PIPK terms, 9 September 2026: eveningwear MOQ is 50 pieces per style and colour; sample development is RMB 2,000. Other 30-50 piece first orders depend on stock fabric and trims, at a higher unit price. Supplier minimums may prevent small runs. Sample fees can be credited against bulk production as confirmed in the quotation.

GATE	TYPICAL CHECKS	DECISION
Material release	Article, colour, width, shrinkage, surface and lot consistency.	Approve, segregate, test further or hold before cutting.
Cutting release	Pattern version, marker, grain, bundle and panel identification.	Confirm the correct components enter sewing.
Inline review	Measurements, seam method, alignment, attachment and workmanship.	Correct issues before they repeat across the order.
Finishing review	Pressing, shape, surface, loose threads, hardware and detail placement.	Repair, rework or release to final inspection.
Final inspection	Approved reference, measurements, colour, assortment, labels and packing.	Release only against the order-specific requirement.

Send enough information for a useful first assessment.

- ☐ Reference photos, sketches, sample or tech pack.
- ☐ Target customer, market and retail position.
- ☐ Fabric composition, hand feel, weight and colour direction.
- ☐ Fit intent, size range and measurement priorities.
- ☐ Required construction, lining, trims and specialist workmanship.
- ☐ Quantity by style and colour.
- ☐ Labels, tags, packaging, testing and compliance needs.
- ☐ Target sample date and intended production window.

FIRST REVIEW

PIPK can assess whether the style fits the available development route, which information is still missing and what should be confirmed before sample quotation.

For reference-image development, the goal is to translate inspiration into the buyer's own proportions, details, construction, materials and colours rather than reproduce another brand's product.



Start with one real style and the questions it needs to answer.

Send the design reference, target market, quantity framework, material direction and required delivery window.

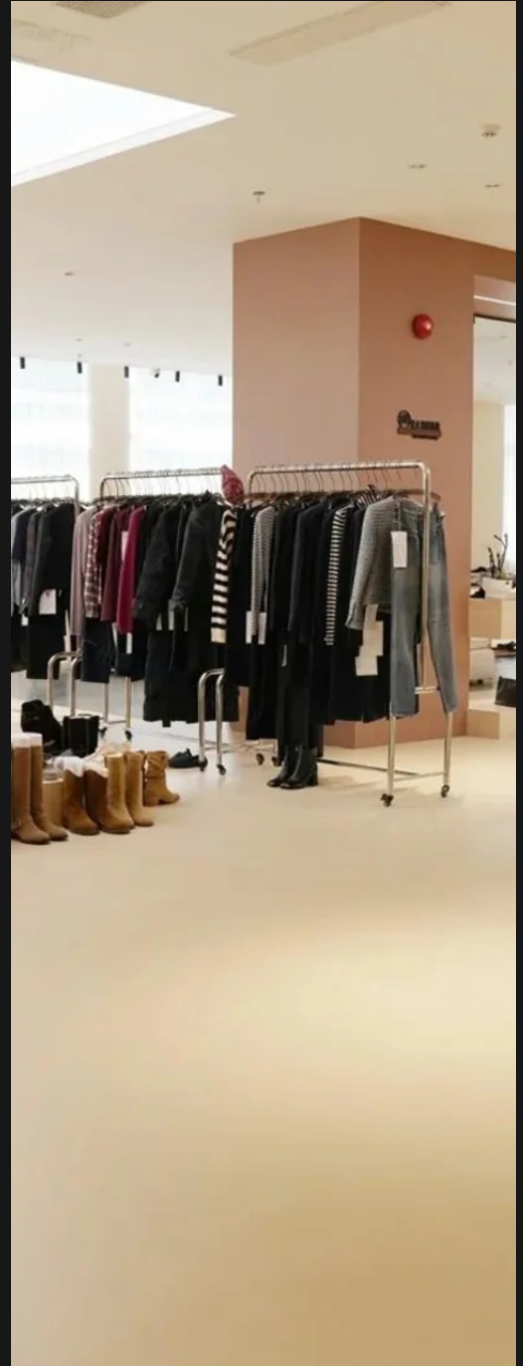
